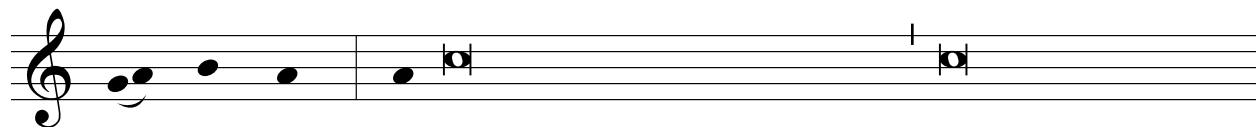
-den and revealed himself to Mar-y Mag-da-lene, who had loved



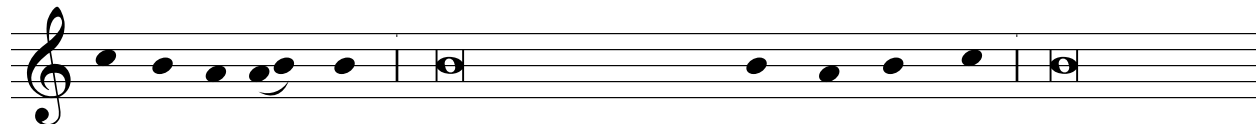
him in life, witnessed him dying on the Cross, sought him as he



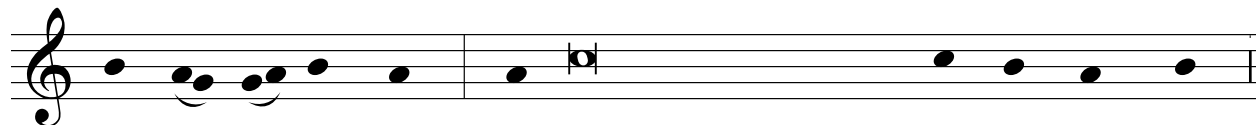
lay in the tomb, and was the first to a-dore him, newly ris-en



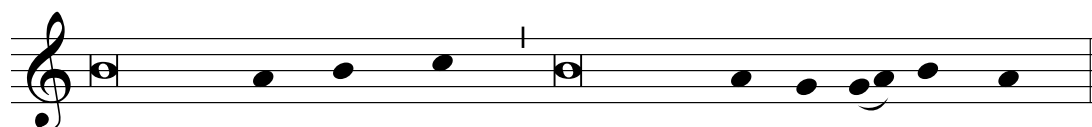
from the dead. He honored her with the office of being an apostle
