5. Organize your community to take part in a civil dialogue.
6. Ask your friends if their faith impacts their political engagement. Why or why not?
7. Choose an issue that you don't know much about and learn more. Take time to [form your conscience](#) through prayer, studying Church teaching, talking with experts, and reflection.
8. Make a commitment to defend life and human dignity and promote justice and peace wherever possible.
9. Pray [this novena](#) before an election.
10. For heaven's sake—VOTE if you're eligible! Help your friends get registered to vote, too.
