Blessing of the Oil of the Sick (no. 20)

O God, Father of all con-so-la-tion, who willed to heal the
infirmities of the weak through your Son, listen favorably to the
prayer of faith: send forth from the heavens, we pray, your Holy
Spirit, the Paraclete, upon this oil in all its rich-ness, which you
have graciously brought forth from the verdant tree to re-store the
bo-dy, so that by your holy blessing ✠ everyone anointed with
this oil as a safeguard for body, soul, and spi-rit may be freed
from all pain, all infirmity, and all sick-ness. † May your holy oil,

O Lord, be blessed by you for our sake in the name of Jesus
Christ our Lord.

Or, when the blessing takes place outside the Eucharistic Prayer, it concludes:

† May your holy oil, O Lord, be blessed by you for our sake in the
name of Jesus Christ our Lord. Who lives and reigns with you for
ev - er and ev - er. **R.** A - men.
