Dear Pastor/Parish Administrator,

Our life as Christian disciples is one of joy, in which we are called to “be filled with the Spirit, addressing one another [in] psalms and hymns and spiritual songs” (Eph 5:18-19). Since the Second Vatican Council, the Church has called for translating both the Bible and liturgical books, such as hymnals and missals, into the everyday languages of people, to draw all God’s children more closely to Christ.

Bible and liturgical translation is an ongoing process throughout the world, as the Church works to foster unity while recognizing the dignity, traditions, and gifts of the different cultures it evangelizes. In Africa, the Southern African Catholic Bishops’ Conference and the Namibian Catholic Bishops’ Conference published Bibles and hymnals in local languages that allow diverse peoples to study and worship in their own tongues. Through grants from the Solidarity Fund for the Church in Africa, the Namibian Catholic Bishops’ Conference supported the publication of the Tutange Bible in the native language of the Rukwangali people as well as a hymnal in the Rumanyo language. In the Pastoral Conference Xhosa region, comprising eight dioceses in South Africa, the Southern African Catholic Bishops’ Conference used a grant from the Solidarity Fund to print updated hymnals in the Xhosa language, which is spoken by about 150,000 Catholics.

Throughout Africa, pastoral efforts to bring the liturgy and Sacred Scripture alive in the native languages of believers are made possible when your parish joins Catholics throughout the United States in supporting the collection for the Solidarity Fund for the Church in Africa.

The most effective way you can help is to highlight the Solidarity Fund at Mass and encourage your parishioners to be generous through the offertory collection envelope or your parish’s e-offertory platform. 


