by the Centers for Disease Control which has been most helpful in navigating the set up and day-to-day operation of the present pandemic precautions and operations.






Webinar Registration Instruction



3. When you click on "Register", click on the blue button "Complete Registration Now."









STEPS FOR WEBINAR REGISTRATION






STEPS FOR WEBINAR REGISTRATION
