Accompanying elder religious in the later years of their spiritual journey relies on the energy of thanksgiving, of gratitude for what has been, of gratitude for what can be let go, celebrated and forgiven, and deep thanks for the life that still fills our days.

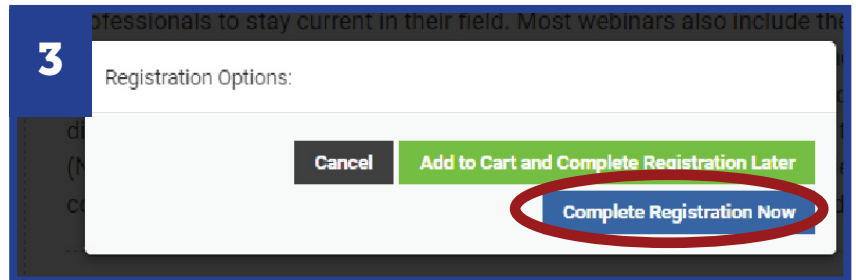

In this webinar, we will explore current trends and options in end-of-life care with consideration of how they align with our Catholic teachings. We will discuss topics such as the benefits of advanced care planning with a focus on personal values. Considerations of what constitutes ordinary vs. extraordinary means to preserve life will be explored, along with understanding artificial nutrition and hydration and its place in end-of-life care.
